Review the purpose


- To point out the different reactions
- If discrepancy in reactions- which is 'best'
- If discrepancy in reactions-which is the most accurate
- Remind/inform colleagues that they have different dispositions to react-they have an attachment strategy that changes even distorts reactions



Senior practitioners


- Note overwhelming denotative language-analytical, diminishing or dismissing image
